- WHEN AND WHERE:** June 22nd – Bethpage State Park Polo Grounds
- AGE GROUPS AND FEES:** U7 thru U14 - **\$525 per team**
Early Registration Fee - **\$435 per team**
Deadline April 30th, 2018
- FORMAT:**
- U7-U10** (7v7) – 40 minutes (2- 20 minute halves)
 - U11-U12** (9v9) -40 minutes (2- 20 minute halves)
 - U13-U14** (11v11) – 40 minutes (2-20 minute halves)
- 3 games guaranteed
- ENTRY:** Complete the online application entry form accessed from the tournament page. Payment can be made in the form of credit card or eCheck. (Paying by **credit card and eCheck** has a 3.5% convenience charge that is added to the entry fee.)
- DEADLINES:** Qualified teams will be accepted on a rolling basis provided application and entry fee are submitted. Once divisions are filled, additional entrants will be put on a waiting list.

- REGISTRATION:** You must register online by Wednesday, June 19th, 2018. If you don't register online, There will be a **mandatory** registration on Friday, June 21st at 1425 Old Country Rd. Plainview, NY 11803.

 - Completed online roster from your team GotSoccer account
 - All online player waivers must be completed
 - Coach's agreement (found on the last page of the tournament rules)
